then in the A bill there are also a smaller item affecting the University and state colleges but the bulk of the money would be for the continuation of the current health plan for one more year.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We are voting on the Warner motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are overriding a veto so it takes 30 votes. Two are excused.

SENATOR WESELY: Let's ask for a roll call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: A roll call vote has been requested. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Could we have a Call of the House with that.

SPEAKER NICHOL: A Call of the House has been requested. The question is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The House is under Call. Will you please return to your desks and record your presence. Those outside the Chambers, please return to the Chambers and record your presence. Thank you. Senator Vard Johnson, Senator Howard Peterson. Senator DeCamp, Senator Schmit, Senator Harris. I believe they are all here. A roll call vote has been asked and we are voting on the override of LB 880. Proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2167-2168 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to override.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 880 veto is overridden. 880A. The Call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move that 880A become law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor.
