CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move to amend.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Warner.

CLERK: This is the earlier amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, the one I withdrew so you know if anyone had contacted you was the one that would have just extended the Board in Dentistry for two more years. That is withdrawn. This amendment is a necessary amendment. It was one that was the reason the bill was held up in the first place and that was to harmonize the provisions of 470 with an earlier bill whose number I forget that also dealt with the sunset of one of the Boards in the Bureau of Examiners and it was necessary or at least it saved some problems for the Revisor if those two bills were not passed the same day and this amendment merely harmonizes the other bill with the sections of law and needs to be enacted. So I move its adoption. It has no impact on the Board or any change.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any discussion on the Warner amendment to the bill? If not, all those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment to the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The Warner amendment is adopted. Any further amendments?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Vard Johnson would move to amend the bill.
