collections during the previous year whichever is greater. My amendment would change the bonding requirement for collection agencies to \$15,000 for the agencies who have 16 or more licensed solicitors, \$10,000 for agencies having 5 to 15 solicitors, and \$5,000 for the agency having less than 5 licensed solicitors. This was worked out with Senator Landis on behalf of the Government Committee and more reasonably fits the various size of the agencies. I move for the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: All those in favor of the amendment will vote aye, opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Nichol and Landis amendment to LB 471, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The amendment is adopted. Any further amendments?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, let the record show that for the first time a board or commission has been sunsetted and the Government Committee has reported out LB 471 to do that.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Lundy, do you want to move the bill, 471?

SENATOR LUNDY: Mr. President, I move that LB 471 be advanced.

SENATOR CLARK: You heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. The bill is advanced. Do you have an A bill on it? We will go to 516.

CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to 516, Senator, I have
