SENATOR CLARK: Everyone will check in, please. Senator Nichol, will you check in, please. We have five excused, so we are all here. All right, there are four excused now. They are all here. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on pages 2176-77 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is declared passed. The Clerk will now read 130A. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: How many votes does this require?

SENATOR CLARK: It would take 30 votes because this is not in the Governor's budget.

CLERK: (Read LB 130A on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CLARK: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. It takes 30 votes.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting no.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? Once more, have you all voted? Record the vote. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I am going to ask for a roll call vote please.

SENATOR CLARK: A roll call vote has been requested. The Clerk will call the roll. They are all in here.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2177-2178 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill fails. The Clerk will now read 1064.
