SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Well, for once I get to stand on the floor, Mr. President and members, and thoroughly agree with my good friend Senator Newell. I would hope that you would adopt the Newell amendment. This would in my opinion help 981 and its chances for passage considerably. It also would include some language that probably would help 981 and that is the remainder of the language that Senator Newell is introducing to this bill. So I would ask you to vote to bring the bill back from Final Reading to Select File and adopt this amendment by Senator Newell. Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the return of the bill for an amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We are voting to return the bill for an amendment by Senator Newell. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is returned. Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Newell amendment. Any discussion? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
