SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is returned. Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President, I would move that the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Is there any discussion on the adoption of the amendment? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the adoption of the Lamb amendment. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays on adoption of Senator Lamb's amendment.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, I would just ask briefly to pass over the bill so that those of us that are interested in it might be able to work out...I think there is some dozen amendments up there. We would like to narrow it down to maybe one or two.
