SENATOR MCDONALD: Well, Senator Hefner, they have estimated it would create a minimum of 15 to 17 additional hearings per year because of the amendment that was adopted. And also the time limits imposed for those hearings, that is what the fiscal analysis is estimating that these costs would run.

SENATOR HEFNER: Does that mean then that they will have to beef up their staff?

SENATOR MCDONALD: I don't think so. As I understand it, it would be additional work for the judges on the Commission.

SENATOR HEFNER: Oh, yes. Okay, thank you.

SENATOR CLARK: The question is the adoption of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted on the adoption of the amendment? (Gavel.) Really, all we have is confusion. We are not having anyone paying attention. Once again, have you all voted? I am going to call the vote. Record the vote.

SENATOR MCDONALD: Mr. President, I would like to request a Call of the House and call in votes.

SENATOR CLARK: I don't know what you would want a Call of the House for. He has 25 votes.

SENATOR MCDONALD: Oh, has he? Okay, I would like to withdraw the...

SENATOR CLARK: Unless you would just like to have a Call of the House.

SENATOR MCDONALD: I would like to withdraw the request.
