CLERK: 25 ayes, 10 nays on the motion to advance 112, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: 112 is advanced. 112A.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have E & R amendments to 112A.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the E & R amendments.

SENATOR CLARK: You heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I would move the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: You heard that motion. All those in favor say aye...you want to have a machine vote on it? All right. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 9 nays on the motion to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: 112A is advanced. We are now going to take up 229.
