CLERK: 28 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill is on Select File. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I would move for the adoption of the amendment and I am sure the motorcyclists of this state would be interested in knowing how people stand. I would like a record vote on the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? If not, the motion is the adoption of the Landis amendment to LB 1089. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. A record vote requested. We are voting on the motion of Senator Landis to amend LB 1089. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 2247 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Landis, do you want to readvance the bill?

SENATOR LANDIS: I move to readvance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to readvance the bill from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried, the bill is readvanced.

CLERK: Senator Landis, am I to assume that you wish to withdraw the second amendment then? Thank you, Senator. Senator Carsten, 835. Mr. President, Senator Carsten would move to return LB 835 to Select File for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carsten.
