Pat, right? Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I would move to return the bill for a specific amendment and that is to strike the E clause. The reason for this, it would avoid some potential due process that Attorney General's opinion has said might arise if the change was effective immediately. That is in regards to the appeal statute. So, if we let this...take the E clause off and let it become effective after 90 days, the objection would be more acceptable so with that explanation, I would move for the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to return the bill to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. This motion is by Senator Carsten to return LB 835 to Select File for a specific amendment. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on Senator Carsten's motion to return LB 835.

PRESIDENT: The bill is on Select File, Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: I would move for the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the Carsten amendment as explained. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Carsten's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Carsten, do you want to readvance the bill?

SENATOR CARSTEN: Move to readvance LB 835 as amended, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to readvance LB 835 from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried, the bill is advanced.
