SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Newell would move to amend, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Now, Senator Newell, your first amendment.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, the amendment that I offered is one that I explained on General File. The problem is that I explained the one that is in your bill book but we adopted one that was the original committee amendments. The one that was in your bill book, that is in your bill book, is the compromise that everybody had agreed to. That is the one I explained on General File. That is the one that ought to be adopted. It is not presently adopted. It has the criteria, 40 years that I talked about before. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: (No response.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion? The question is the adoption of the Newell amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the adoption of the Newell amendment. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Newell's amendment to 1084, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Newell amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Newell, you have the emergency clause.

SENATOR NEWELL: Right. I'd like to add the emergency clause. The reason to add the emergency clause is that people can't, you know, figure out where to go. We need to do that. That's it. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any discussion? The question is the
