recall from the debate on the bill that the advance sheets  
are the little paperback pamphlets that are passed out that  
report the current decisions of the Supreme Court and we had  
provided for twenty of them back to the Supreme Court and  
that is being reduced to ten. We are reducing the number of  
copies that are being distributed except we are providing  
for one copy to the Clerk of the Legislature but over all,  
it is reducing the number of copies that are being  
distributed by several...by many copies, Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: I really understand that. Thank you very  
much.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further debate on the issue? The  
question is the adoption of the Beutler amendment. All  
those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Beutler's  
amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Lundy, would you like to move the
