SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely. Okay, Senator Shirley Marsh, did you wish to close? The question is the adoption of the Shirley Marsh amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Marsh's amendment to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Marsh amendment is adopted. Anything else on the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Pappas had an amendment to the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Pappas. It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Rod Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: (Mike not on immediately.) ...LB 660.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. LB 906.

CLERK: Mr. President, 906, first of all I have E & R amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Rod Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, I'd move for the adoption of the E & R amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have amendments from Senator Howard Peterson. Do you wish to withdraw those, Senator? Mr. President, Senator Wesely and Howard Peterson would move to amend. (Amendments appear on page 2285 of the Legislative Journal.)
