LB 904, 916

PRESIDENT: LB 904 is declared passed and the new assistant clerk of the Legislature, Senator Landis, will read LB 916.

SENATOR LANDIS: (Began reading LB 916 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR HIGGINS: (Interruption.) Well evidently he is not trained in enunciation. Could he read the last sentence over for me, please? I could not understand it.

PRESIDENT: With feeling.

SENATOR LANDIS: (Continued to read LB 916 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: Motion on the desk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion from Senators Lamb and Kahle. They would move to return LB 916 to Select File for a specific amendment, that amendment is to strike all references to reasonable attorney fees. (laughter.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Kahle.

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. President, that was the only part of the bill that I heard and I really don't like to vote on something like that but if it is...with Senator Lamb's permission we will withdraw that amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is withdrawn. All provisions of law relative to procedure, I think, having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 916 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Please record your vote on LB 916. Senator Lamb, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR LAMB: I'd just point out that Senator Landis violated the rules of this Legislature by not sitting in his seat during the reading of the bill on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: I was waiting for someone to make that point of order. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.
