PRESIDENT: Thank you, we will do that. Will all members please check in and record their presence on the board. Members are expected to be in their seats during Final Reading. Please record your presence. Senator Lowell Johnson, please, and Senator Hefner. Senator Hannibal, please. Senator Jacobson and Von Minden. Four members are excused and this is the full complement of membership today unexcused. A roll call vote has been requested on LB 255. Please preserve order in the Chamber so the Clerk can hear your vote. (Gavel.) Proceed.
