LB 645A, 667, 679

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 645A passes. LB 667.

ASSISTANT CLERK: First of all, Mr. President, Senator Hoagland had an amendment on page 1861. I understand he wants to withdraw that.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hoagland, do you wish to withdraw your motion on this bill? It is withdrawn.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 667 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 2359 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 41 ayes, 4 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 667 passes. LB 679.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 679 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR BEUTLER PRESIDING

SENATOR BEUTLER: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Beutler voting yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 2360 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.
