ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Kilgarin voting yes.

SENATOR KILGARIN: Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 2367-68 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Madam President.

SENATOR KILGARIN: LB 801 passes on Final Reading. Before we proceed to LB 801A I would like to introduce some guests of Senator Landis under the north balcony, Michael K-ser and his sons, Duncan and Alex. They are from England. Mr. K-ser is an exchange teacher at Northeast High School here in Lincoln. We would like to welcome you. LB 801A.
