ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Newell voting yes.

SENATOR NEWELL: Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 2379-80 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR NEWELL: LB 1007 passes. The Clerk will now read LB 1010.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1010 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR NEWELL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Senator Hannibal, you have to move quick. Senator Johnson, you must move quick. And since everybody has voted who wants to vote, the Clerk shall record.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 2380-81 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR NEWELL: LB 1010 passes and Senator Landis wins another one. LB 1058.

CLERK: (Read LB 1058 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 2381 of the Legislative Journal.)
