ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 2410 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 44 ayes, 4 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is declared passed. The Clerk will now read 112.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 112 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CLARK: All provisions of law according to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Clark voting no.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2410-2411 of the Legislative Journal.) 29 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is declared passed. The Clerk will now read 112A. This will require 30 votes.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 112A on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CLARK: All provisions of law according to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Clark voting no.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? Once more, have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2411 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 30 ayes, 18 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is declared passed. The Clerk will now read 848 with the emergency clause.
