LB 645A, 769, 809, 981, 981A, 983

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is declared passed. Now read LB 981A.

CLERK: (Read LB 981A on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CLARK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. This requires 30 votes. Have you all voted? Once more, have you all voted? Record the vote. Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: I would like to ask everyone to check in and have a roll call vote.

SENATOR CLARK: All right, everyone check in please. If everyone will get in their seats please and we will check in. Should have 49, there is no one excused. Senator Kahle, Senator Pappas, Senator Higgins, will you all check in please. Senator Warner, will you check in please. All right, they are all here. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2429 of the Legislative Journal.) 30 ayes, 18 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is declared passed.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a series of messages from the Governor. (Read. Re: LB 809.) The next message, Mr. President, is addressed to Dear Mr. President and Senators. (Read. Re: LB 769.) Mr. President, the third, (read. Re: LB 645A.) (See pages 2429-2431 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CLARK: The Clerk will now read 983.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may right before that, I have an explanation of vote from Senator Abboud. Mr. President, I have a motion on LB 983. Senator Beutler would move to return the bill for specific amendment.
