We find it very easy to spend money in this body but we find it very difficult to fund those projects which provide the resources which year in and year out provide the tax base to provide the revenue for all of the very laudable goals that you want to pursue in this body. The Governor has made it very clear to us he supports LB 1106. He is very concerned, as we all are, about the total funding of the State of Nebraska. I believe it is only fair that we send to the Governor LB 1106A and allow him to hopefully provide the funds that are necessary for 1106. The bill carries \$10 million, a substantial reduction from the amount of money which we expected to spend a year ago. But I would hope that this body would send that bill to the Governor, give an opportunity to fund the bill which is most important to us. I appreciate Senator Clark's offering the motion. I hope you will support it.
