LB 561

SENATOR KAHLE: Senator Clark, do you...okay, we are voting on the Final Reading reconsideration of LB 561. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed...okay, a roll call vote has been requested. We are not under Call. Request has been made to go under Call. All those in favor of going under Call vote aye, those opposed no. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call.

SENATOR KAHLE: We are under Call. All of you that are here, please return to your seats. All unauthorized persons, please leave the floor. Those senators within hearing range of my voice, please return to the Chamber. We are under Call. Please check in. Senator Abboud, Eret, Goodrich. Senator Schmit. Senator Schmit is missing. Okay, the Clerk will proceed. Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, would you state the motion and how many votes it takes.

SENATOR KAHLE: Okay, we are voting on the reconsideration of LB 561. It takes 30 votes to reconsider and then 25 votes if we do anything after that. The Clerk will proceed with the roll call.

CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on page 2452 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR KAHLE: The bill is returned. All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? And we will have a machine vote. Roll call vote has been requested. Okay, we are under Call so we will proceed with a roll call vote and we have had a request for reverse order. That will be granted.

CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on page 2453 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President.
