SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, then the question is the suspension of the rules and voting on them all at one time. Senator Landis. Okay, you suspend the rules first and then vote on the resolutions. I am sorry. The question is, shall the rules be suspended? Will you please vote aye or nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to suspend rules to consider the resolutions, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The rules are suspended. Now to vote on the resolutions. (Re: LR's 251, 456-457, 459-464, 467, 469-470, and 451.) Any discussion? The question is, shall the resolutions be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the resolutions.

SPEAKER NICHOL: They are all adopted. Senator Marsh, shall we go back to yours?
