LR 11 by Senator Vard Johnson would propose a constitutional amendment to Article XIII, Section 3 of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska. (See page 136 of the Legislative Journal.)

And LR 12 by Senator Vard Johnson, Senator DeCamp, Senator Hoagland and Senator Beutler, it will propose an amendment to Article III, Section 17, IV, section 5, and by adding a new section 5A thereto to the Constitution of the State of Nebraska.
