LB 7, 8, 248-304

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 248-304 for first time by title. Refer to pages 208 through 221 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler, are you in the Chamber? Would you like to take a few of these? We have to number some more bills, so stick around, those of you that are here. Senator Beutler.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first bill, excuse me, Senator, is LB 7. (Read title.) The bill was referred directly to General File.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler. (Gavel.) May I please have your attention so that we can hear Senator Beutler explain our Revisor statutes that you will be voting on in a minute. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, once again the next six bills are Revisor statutes which are purely technical in nature. I'll try to go through them quickly so I don't take much of your time. LB 7, which is the one we are on right now, basically provides for the transfer of certain records from the Secretary of State to the Department of Administrative Services which was to be completed by October 23, 1967, and it was completed and the statute is now irrelevant. I move that the bill be advanced, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any discussion? All those in favor of...all those in the affirmative vote aye. Opposed nay. May I please have your attention. Please vote. We have a limited number here and it would speed things up if you would vote, please. Thank you.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 7.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 7 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 8.
