SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the bill? The question is, shall the bill advance? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 86 advances. We will move on to LB 557.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I might right before that, a few items for the record. Senator Beutler would like to print amendments to 179. I have a report for Business and Labor Committee reporting LB 229 as indefinitely postponed. That is signed by Senator Barrett as Chair. Retirement Systems offers notice of hearing, as does Miscellaneous Subjects. Public Works offers notice of hearing. I have a confirmation hearing report by the Retirement Systems Committee signed by Senator Harris. (See page 506 of the Legislative Journal.)

New A bill, Mr. President, 101A by Senator Goodrich. (Read title for the first time as found on pages 508 of the Legislative Journal.)

Your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 338 and recommend that same be placed on Select File; 341 Select File with E & R amendments; 339 Select File with E & R amendments. All of those are signed by Senator Hall as Chair. (See pages 508-09 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, new A bill, 323A offered by Senator Lynch. (Read title for the first as found on page 508 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. LB 557.

CLERK: Mr. President, 557 was a bill introduced by Senators Rupp and Scofield. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 22 of this year, referred to the Constitutional Committee for hearing. It was advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.
