

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 417 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 417 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote. Have you all recorded your vote? The Clerk will record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 579-580 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 49 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, LB 417 is declared passed. That completes Final Reading. The Chair recognizes Senator Rogers on a point of personal privilege.

SENATOR ROGERS: Mr. President, members of the body, I have an appointment with Governor Wilkenson who is the head of the Farm Credit System on Monday, February 25th. I would simply like to ask if there is one or two Senators in this body who would like to go with me, I have to have their names today, no later than tomorrow. SENATOR HIGGINS: I would like to ask Senator Rogers a question.

SENATOR ROGERS: His title is Governor. He is not from any state. He is the head of the United States Farm Credit System and his title is Governor.
