

SENATOR SIECK: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Speaker, I would like to ask Senator Wesely some questions.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Senator Wesely, how are they taxed, these, modular, mobile?

SENATOR WESELY: Property taxes?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yes, for property tax. Are they taxed as a regular dwelling or...?

SENATOR WESELY: I assume they are taxed as any other home would be. I am not...I don't know and it has nothing to do with this bill, Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay, that doesn't change the taxation of it?

SENATOR WESELY: Oh, no, no, huh uh.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Wesely, just a couple more questions this morning, if I may. As I understand it, this is like the child support bill that we are going to see later in that all of these changes are required by the federal government. Is that correct?

SENATOR WESELY: We must adopt these changes or be out of compliance and as a result our manufacturers would not be able to sell outside the state.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Senator Landis' amendment aside dealing with rentals, are there any provisions in this bill that are not required by the federal government or in any way vary from federal government requirements?

SENATOR WESELY: I know the committee amendment that changed
