

SENATOR BEUTLER: Right.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: But I assume that you want to address this problem so that it will not happen again. Is that basically the concern?

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right, that's right. I guess the feeling is why have the problem. Lincoln School Board members are not paid anything, so we're not incurring any additional expense by solving the problem in this manner. It just seemed to make some sense.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Okay, that's all I need. Thank you.
