

well how come Omaha National and First National aren't protecting theirs, they are not taking their stock loans over, they are not making those banks function. You see the bill would be a sham at ten percent, at least I believe it would. It wouldn't give the flexibility necessary.

PRESIDENT: One minute.

SENATOR DECAMP: I urge you not to adopt the amendment. I specifically asked Senator Carsten, Carson Rogers, you gentlemen understand this as well as anybody in this body. Carson Rogers is on the PCA. Cal has as much knowledge of banking as anybody in this body. Please do not adopt this amendment. It will do serious damage to the ability to take over some institutions. Yes, there are going to be some institutions fail. Yes, they are going to be happening regularly. Yes, the banking structure has to be a critical part of bailing out this whole farm situation. Don't put the shackles on the institutions that have the ability to reach out and stretch out and stabilize it. I urge you not to adopt the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The Chair reminds members of the body that we are on Final Reading, and strictly speaking you are required to be in your seats during Final Reading. If there are members in the Rotunda, please return to the Chamber. Other members, please take your seats. We are on Final Reading, in spite of the fact that we have a debate issue going on. The Chair recognizes Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, members of the body, Senator Remmers made the remarks local control, and we need banks in our local communities. Well, Senator Remmers, there may not be any banks in the local communities to have local control. Right now there are six to seven banks that are on the shaky list. If something isn't going to be done you are going to lose those banks in those communities. So, I want you to remember, Senators, when you vote remember how you voted if one of those six or seven banks, in the next month, that fail are in your district when you could have helped that bank be alive and viable to your district. Remember that because that is when the chips are going to be down. That is when you are going to have to answer why did you vote the way you did when you were told repeatedly on this floor that they are going to fail without the bill. So, therefore, I urge you not to adopt this amendment. If
