LB 217, 486, 716

CLERK: 30 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to introduce a new bill.

PRESIDENT: 30 votes have been received and that is sufficient to suspend the rules and introduce the bill under the one motion. It is so done.

CLERK: Mr. President, new bill, LB 716. (Read for the first time by title as found on page 864 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be referred to the Reference Committee, Mr. President.

Mr. President, I have amendments by Senator Vickers to be printed in the Journal to LB 217. (See pages 865-66 of the Legislative Journal.)

I have notice of hearing from Senator Vard Johnson as Chairman of the Revenue Committee.

PRESIDENT: We move then to Select File, LB 486.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 486, first of all has E & R amendments pending.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Labeledz would move to amend the bill. Senator Labeledz's amendment is on page 676 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President. This amendment to LB 486 would permit nonprofit organizations to continue to award prizes to their volunteers for selling raffle tickets. Presently, some hospitals and schools and other nonprofit organizations reward their top ticket sellers.
