

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Warner. (The Warner amendment appears on pages 877-78 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this amendment is not passed out. It was brought to my attention by the bill drafters and it is more than what E & R amendments might be, but it makes no substantive changes. What it does is one of the amendments instead of referring to previous sections of law it refers to the Abstracters Act which is what the bill is now titled. Then there is a definition as to what a certificate of registration shall mean and there was not one in the act. Again, it makes no substantive change but it does provide a definition where a definition should be. Then it indicates because there are, as has been indicated, currently two members that are attorneys on the board, one of which is being eliminated and replaced by a person representing the public. So this amendment merely states that the first vacancy that occurs, which is an attorney, shall be filled by that person representing the public. And then the bill, as almost all of our licensing boards now, contains a range for the fees, a minimum and a maximum which we need to constitutionally do and then the board having the authority within that range to set the fees and we govern their expenditures by the level of appropriation. But in all cases it has been necessary to add the words, and what we have done in every other similar situation, is the board shall establish such fees based on the administrative costs of the board and that is boiler plate language in a number of statutes now. But again the cost is essentially controlled within the range that the fees permit by the appropriation. And the rest of the amendment would be nothing other than the corrections in renumbering, and so forth. So I would move adoption of the amendment.
