

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails. The house is under call on an amendment by Senator Wesely to LR 23. All members of the Legislature please report back to the Legislative Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Under the rules members are required to be in your seats during the time the house is under call. Unauthorized personnel are to leave the floor. Two members are excused at the present time. Senator Harris, Senator Rupp, Senator Warner, Senator Labedz. Senator Labedz, would you record your presence. Senator Sieck, please. Senator Sieck, record your presence. Senator Chambers, Senator Chizek, Senator Beutler. Call ins may be made to the Clerk on this motion which is the motion to adopt an amendment offered by Senator Wesely and explained by him. If you wish to call in your vote to the Clerk, you may.

CLERK: Senator Beutler voting yes. Senator Conway voting yes. Senator Haberman voting...changing from yes to no. Senator Vickers voting yes. Senator Miller voting yes. Senator Rupp voting yes. Senator Morehead voting yes. Senator Sieck voting yes. Senator Baack voting yes. Senator Goodrich, you had voted yes, Senator. Senator Pirsch voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 9 nays on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.
