motion to advance the A bill. Vote aye or nay. Voting on the advancement of LB 250A. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance 250A.

PRESIDENT: LB 250A. Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, the next bill up is one of Senator Landis and Senator Chronister and both have agreed to let me go over them to the next one which deals with incorporating provisions of the Federal Indian Child Welfare Act into the statutes of Nebraska. And if the body would indulge me for just a few minutes, the bill is not complex, it won't take long, I would like the opportunity to do so.

PRESIDENT: Very well, will the Clerk read LB 255? Senator Abboud. Senator Abboud, we have moved over...

SENATOR ABBOUD: I will graciously allow Senator Chambers' bill to go next.

CLERK: Mr. President, 255 was a bill that was introduced...

PRESIDENT: I have 384 crossed out. Is that wrong?

CLERK: I'm sorry.

PRESIDENT: Okay, go ahead, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 255 by Senator Chambers. (Read title.) It was first read on January 17, advanced to Judiciary. There are committee amendments pending, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: And what committee is that? Senator Hoagland, do you want to handle the Judiciary Committee amendments to LB 255? Or Senator Chambers, whichever you wish. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, the committee amendment becomes the bill and what the bill does is incorporate into Nebraska statutes the existing federal requirements with reference to the adoption of any Indian child or the termination of parental rights.
