PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? You may call in your vote to the Clerk. Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Chambers voting no. Senator Landis voting no.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Scofield voting no.

PRESIDENT: Senator Baack.

CLERK: Senator Chizek voting no. Senator Baack voting no.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 10 ayes on the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President. (See page 1162 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The DeCamp amendment to LB 691 is adopted. The Chair would interrupt debate to announce that Senator Haberman has guests, I don't know exactly where they are in the balcony, but they are 15 to 20 Chase County High School American Government class students from Imperial. They are accompanied by Arliss Kunnemann, a teacher, and also a teacher, Jeff Hall, who is a brother of Senator Tim Hall, and one student, Brad Moline who has the privilege of having his 18th birthday today. And also Senator Arlene Nelson has asked me to announce that she has guests Angie Gregg and her senior class from Bertrand. They are accompanied by their sponsor Ron Kubik and I guess Bertrand is also in Senator Jacklyn Smith's district.
