CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on page 1192 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 23 nays on the motion to indefinitely postpone the bill, Mr. President.

The Chair will announce that we have guests in the north balcony who are statewide in their representation, who are 40 members of the Province of Nebraska Catholic Women. Accompanying them are Joan Walsh, Legislative Coordinator, and Eulaia Hansen, Province Director. If you will all stand and be recognized, we would like to welcome you to the Nebraska Legislature.
