CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance LB 253,  
Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. We move now to LB 253A.

CLERK: 253A by Senator Wesely. (Title read.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Again for Senator Warner's  
benefit and everybody else this A bill will be covered by  
revenues generated as a result of the amendment we adopted.  
So I ask your support for the A bill.

PRESIDENT: Are there further discussion on 253A? If not,  
the motion is to advance LB 253A from General File. All  
those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all  
voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance LB 253A.

PRESIDENT: LB 253A is advanced. We move to LB 569.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I might right before that, Senator  
Remmers would like to print amendments to 504 in the  
Journal.

Ag and Environment reports 596 to General File; 459  
General File with amendments; 460 General File with  
amendments; 628 General File with amendments and 537  
indefinitely postponed, all signed by Senator Rod Johnson as  
Chair.

Mr. President, LB 569 was a bill introduced by Senator Rupp.  
(Title read.) The bill was read on January 22, referred to  
Public Works, advanced to General File.

PRESIDENT: Okay, Senator Rupp.
