CLERK: 25 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 457.

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do. Mr. President, Senator Scofield and Wesely have amendments to 457 to be printed; Senator Landis and Barrett amendments to 213; Senator DeCamp to 404. (See pages 1676-83 of the Legislative Journal.)

New resolution, Mr. President, signed by Senator Schmit and a number of the members. (Read LR 96. See pages 1675-77 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be laid over, Mr. President. That is all that I have.

PRESIDENT: Very well. Senator Miller, did you want to make a motion? I saw you fondling the microphone there. I have not received any instructions from the Speaker to do other than to go ahead on General File. Senator Miller.
