

SENATOR BEUTLER: Question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed nay.

CLERK: Senator Beutler voting yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Please vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Debate is ceased. Senator Haberman, you are recognized for the purpose of closing on your motion to advance LB 236.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, when we started out on this an hour ago I had no idea that this little prairie dog was going to turn into a snarling mountain lion, I really didn't, but it sure did. Senator Chambers, when you were talking about leaving the revenue bills to the heavyweights, I presume you were talking about Senator DeCamp down here. We have debated this bill, and we've gone through it, tried to amend it. So I just ask that we advance the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The motion before you is the advancement of LB 236. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay.

CLERK: Senator Beutler voting no.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Has everybody voted who wishes to vote? Record vote has been requested. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1779 of the Legislative Journal.) 29 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The bill advances. Do you have matters to read in, Mr. Clerk?
