

SENATOR MARSH PRESIDING

DR. PALMER: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR MARSH: Roll call. Roll call is in progress. Good morning, Senator Pappas. Good morning, Senator Goll. Senators, roll call is in progress. We need your presence in the Legislative Chamber. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: There is a quorum present.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. I have the honor this morning of introducing a very special friend of mine who is visiting in the Legislature, Miss Mary Martin, who is seated on the south side of the Legislative Chamber.
