rather than having to wait for those two projects until the bonds have matured in 1992. So there is no additional expenditure, no additional cost as far as the whole project is concerned, but it will permit those two projects to be completed prior to 1992, and be possible by 1987. So I would move for the bill's introduction.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the introduction of 1045. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the introduction of Req. #1045, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is introduced.

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read by title for the first time LB 727-728 as found on page 1921 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Warner would move to suspend Rule 3, Section 4(e) and 13, and Rule 6, Section 1, and place LB 727 and 728 on General File.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, please.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would move that these bills be taken up along with the other appropriation bills at the appropriate time.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion is to suspend the rules. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. It takes 30 votes. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays to suspend the rules and place the bills directly on General File, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: They are placed on General File. Ready to move on to LB 271.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 271 was a bill that was originally introduced by the Revenue Committee and signed by its members. (Title read.) The bill was first read on January 17. It was referred to the Revenue Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are Revenue Committee amendments pending,
