PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 279 pass? All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1958 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 6 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 279 is declared passed. Next we read LB 207.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Final Reading of LB 207.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 207 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1959 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 42 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1960 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 41 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.
