SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: (Microphone not activated)...Charles Tyler of St. John African Methodist and Episcopal Church of Omaha, guest of Senator Pirsch. Pastor Tyler.

PASTOR TYLER: (Prayer offered.)
