SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Barrett, did you wish to close on the committee amendments?

SENATOR BARRETT: No closing. I move they be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the adoption of the committee amendments. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Barrett, we are on the bill.

SENATOR BARRETT: Very simply, Mr. President, and members, the purpose of the bill, of course, is to make appropriations for the payment of miscellaneous claims against the state which have been approved by the State Claims Board and by the Business and Labor Committee. The bill provides how payment shall be made, declares an emergency. The bill also contains requests by state agencies to write off certain accounts which have been approved by the State Claims Board. I would move the bill be advanced as amended.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion? The question is the advancement of LB 718. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 718.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We will move on to General File and priority bills. LB 687.

CLERK: Mr. President, 687 was considered yesterday by the Legislature. At that time Senator Haberman made a motion to indefinitely postpone the bill. That did lay it over. That is now pending before the Legislature.
