PRESIDENT MCGINLEY PRESIDING

DR. PALMER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Chaplain Palmer. Members, please record your presence for roll call. (Gavel.) Members of the Legislature, a roll call is underway in the Legislative Chamber. If you'd please report to the Chamber for roll call. If members would please come to the Chamber to press your presence button, roll call is underway. Members please record your presence for roll call. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Quorum is present. The Legislature is in session. Do you have corrections to the Journal, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do have one and I am hoping that Senator DeCamp won't take offense, but on page 2074 strike "DeCamp" and insert "Wesely."

PRESIDENT: Strike what and insert what?

CLERK: Strike "DeCamp" and insert "Wesely."

PRESIDENT: Oh. Is there objection? If none, so ordered. Matters for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee offers notice of hearing.

I have a gubernatorial appointment. That will be referred to the Reference Committee.

And, Mr. President, LRs 251, and 253-256 are ready for your signature.
