

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator DeCamp, your amendments to the committee amendments...

SENATOR DECAMP: Actually I guess...I just learned they are to the bill itself. That is why I am suggesting that you just reject the committee amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay.

SENATOR DECAMP: They are the synthesis, if you would, of 8 or 10 critical things that the (interruption)...

SENATOR CARSTEN: Out of that hearing?

SENATOR DECAMP: Absolutely and strictly, very clear.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Thank you, sir.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on Senator DeCamp's motion? It is the suggestion of the Chair under procedure if I may have your attention please, Senator DeCamp has requested that he doesn't want the committee amendments, that they be rejected. The Clerk and parliamentarian suggests that they be rejected by a no vote. In other words, the motion is now to adopt the committee amendments. Those wishing not to vote for the committee amendments vote red. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 0 ayes, 18 nays on adoption of the committee amendments.
