LR 32

CLERK: Senator, I now have a motion from Senator Goll. Senator Goll would move to indefinitely postpone LR 32. That would lay it over unless the introducer agrees to take it up at this time.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Hoagland, the motion has been made for indefinite postponement. Do you choose to take it up now, or postpone it until another day? Senator Goll's motion.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: One moment, Madam Speaker, if I might. We would request to take it up now.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Goll.

SENATOR GOLL: Madam Speaker and colleagues, I really think this bill ought to be indefinitely postponed. I have yet to talk to anyone across this state that is in favor of the appointment of the Regents. I certainly oppose it. But at this time, and with our schedule, I think it is just time to vote it up or down. So I will withdraw my motion.

SENATOR MARSH: The motion has been withdrawn. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Madam President, I would move that LR 32 be advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR MARSH: Machine vote has been requested. There are a number of lights on, but, after the motion was withdrawn, I made the assumption no one chose to speak. If there is anyone wishing to speak, otherwise we are ready to vote on a machine vote for the advancement. Those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Senator Marsh voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting yes.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I'd ask for a call of the house, Madam President.

SENATOR MARSH: Call of the house has been requested. Those in favor vote aye, opposed no. The Clerk will record.
