

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails. The house is under call. Members, please record your presence on the voting board at the front of the Chamber. Members of the Legislature, the house is under call. Please come to the Chamber and record your presence. Eight members are excused at the present time. Members, please record your presence. Senator Scofield, would you record your presence. Senator Eret, Senator DeCamp. Members may call in your vote to the Clerk. Yes, I didn't announce this but there has been a request for a roll call so hold your call ins. Senator Withem, would you check in please. Now all members who are not excused have now checked in, and if we will have quiet in the Chamber please, members in your seats, we are under call, the Clerk will call the roll for the ayes and nays on the advancement of 715A.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2162-63 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted?

CLERK: 20 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of the A bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill fails to advance. The call of the house is raised. Then we proceed to Final Reading. All members in your seats please. All members in your seats. The Chair would like to announce that Senator Eret has guests in the south balcony. There are 22 fourth graders from Exeter Elementary School in Exeter with their teacher and Senator Beyer has 41 fourth graders in the south balcony.
