LB 356

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Richard Peterson and Senator Hoagland would move to return the bill for specific amendment. The amendment is on page 1459.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Peterson.

SENATOR PETERSON: Mr. President and members, I request that you return LB 356 for a specific amendment and that is on page 1459, and if you look at the bill right after "any court", "or by the administrative order of the Director of Motor Vehicles." I would like to have your attention that there is a letter been handed out that was addressed to Senator Hoagland from Holly Jensen, Director of Motor Vehicles, and without this amendment on there, somebody that has gained 12 points and things like that, why she cannot suspend the license so with this, it was a request from the Department of Motor Vehicles that this amendment be added and it just reinstates the penalty for driving on a license that has been revoked or suspended, and without this amendment, it really guts what the Motor Vehicles Department has any authority in regards to this. So I ask you to bring the bill back for this specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Anyone else wish to speak on the motion of Senator Peterson. If not, the motion is to return the bill to Select File, LB 356, for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on Senator Peterson's motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill has been returned to Select File, Senator Peterson.

SENATOR PETERSON: I would just ask that you adopt the amendment. Is there discussion? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment offered by Senator Peterson. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Peterson's amendment to the bill.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted Senator Peterson.
