PRESIDENT MCGINLEY PRESIDING

DR. PALMER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Dr. Palmer. Please record your presence for roll call. Roll call is in progress in the Legislative Chamber. If members would please come to the George W. Norris Unicameral Legislative Chamber, we could begin our 77th Day of legislative activity. Roll call is in progress.

PRESIDENT: Quorum present, the Legislature is in session. Does the Clerk have Journal corrections?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 713 to Select File, as well as 612, both of those with E & R amendments, both signed by Senator Hall as Enrollment and Review Chair. (See pages 2212-13 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I received a series of reports, one from the Ombudsman, 14th Annual Report, a report from the State Board of Vocational Education, and several reports from the Department of Roads, all filed pursuant to statute, all of which will be on file in my office.
